

## Springtime Parade

Stitch a small garden of ruched flowers. Techniques covered are bias stems, blind stitch appliqué, stem stitch embroidery, and strip ruching. All levels.

## Supplies:

Please prepare these items before class.

Fabric for grass - 4 ½" x 20 ½"

Sky fabric - 8 ½" x 20 ½"

Sew these two pieces together for background.

1/4 yd green for stems and leaves - from this, cut seven ½" x 9" bias strips.

For ruched flower petals - three bias strips 1 1/4" x 11" and four bias strips 1 1/4" x 13"

For flower centers - 6" square of fabric with 6" square of fusible web pressed to wrong side

Sewing threads to match fabrics
Quilting thread to match flower petals
Embroidery floss to match leaves
Template material
Fabric marking pencil
